

Appendix 2 - PCSO POWERS

Fixed Penalty notices for disorder for:

- Sale of alcohol to a person under 18
- Purchase of alcohol for a person under 18
- Delivery of alcohol to a person under 18 or allowing such delivery
- Destroying or damaging property (under £500)
- Breach of fireworks curfew
- Possession of a category 4 firework
- Possession by a person under 18 of an adult
- Supply of excessively loud
- Wasting police time, giving false report s5 of the Criminal Law Act 1967 (£80)
- Using public electronic communications network in order to cause annoyance, inconvenience or needless anxiety
- Knowingly giving false alarm to a person acting on behalf of a fire and rescue authority
- Causing harassment, alarm or distress
- Throwing fireworks
- Drunk and disorderly behaviour
- Consumption of alcohol by a person under 18 or allowing such consumption
- Trespassing on a railway
- Throwing stones at a train
- Drunk in the highway
- Drinking in a designated public area
- Power to issue fixed penalty notices for truancy (*This would normally be done in conjunction with an education truancy officer*)
- Power to issue fixed penalty notices for cycling on a footpath
- Power to issue fixed penalty notices for dog fouling (*this would be a local authority penalty notice*)
- Power to issue fixed penalty notices for littering (*this would be a local authority penalty notice*)
- Power to issue fixed penalty notices in respect of offences under dog control orders (*this would be a local authority penalty notice*)
