### **QUESTIONS FROM MEMBERS TO CABINET MEMBERS, COMMITTEE CHAIRS AND MEMBERS APPOINTED TO REPRESENT THE COUNCIL ON A JOINT COMMITTEE**

**1. From Councillor Anderson to Councillor Worrall**

“Last year the Corringham summer fete had to be cancelled because of damage done to the ground in the park by a travelling circus. The Corringham events committee have now been informed that the Council do not expect the ground to be fit for use this summer either, and the event should again be relocated or cancelled.

What steps are you taking to ensure that Corringham park is returned to a condition where it is fully available for community use?”

**2. From Councillor Gledhill to Councillor Holloway**

“Could the Cabinet Member outline how much it has cost to remove abandoned caravans and other rubbish dumped on the Woodview approach road near Dock Road, Little Thurrock over the past 12 months please?”

**3. From Councillor Anderson to Councillor A Smith**

“Has Thurrock Council made any response to the Local Plan Consultation by Castle Point Borough Council in respect of proposals to consider a link road connecting Canvey Island to the A1014 Manorway at Corringham?”
