Thurrock Constitution – Chapter 2 (Council Procedure Rules) Points for discussion for Member Constitution Working Group

Current Rule 5.4 – Opening of the municipal year debate	We propose that this is deleted as it has not been used since it was added to the Constitution, suggesting that there is no appetite for it.
	MCWG to confirm agreement to deletion.
Current Rule 7 – State of Thurrock debate	We propose that this is deleted as this type of meeting has never been used.
	MCWG to confirm agreement to deletion.
Current Rule 8 – Themed meetings	We propose that this is deleted as themed meetings have never been used. Extraordinary meetings could be used for this purpose, if required.
	MCWG to confirm agreement to deletion.
Current Rule 13.4 / new Rule 12.6 – Disposal of remaining business	There is an inconsistency in current Rule 13. Motions that have not been dealt with in the main part of the meeting are to be moved and voted on without debate (current Rule 13.2).
	Current Rule 13.4 then says that, during this process, the only motions that may be moved are: 1. that the matter be delegated or referred; 2. that the matter be deferred; or 3. motions that may be moved during debate.
	Is there a particular reason for this or should 3 be deleted?
New Rule 12.9 – Guillotine	We propose that there is a limit on the amount of time that can be added to a meeting for the disposal of remaining business. The time suggested is 30 minutes (meaning that the maximum length of a meeting would be 3 hours 30 minutes).
	For discussion: - Should there be a hard stop for time allocated to disposal of remaining business?

	 Is 30 minutes an appropriate period of additional time? Is 3 hours 30 minutes an appropriate maximum length for meetings?
New Rule 16.11 – Supplementary questions	We propose that Members are limited to 1 supplementary question. This is partly from a timing perspective, and to keep questions focused. The appointment of political assistants should also help with the quality of questions.
	For discussion: - Should Members be limited to 1 supplementary question?
